What to include	Example of evidence
Plan the time for the project	Document with the time you are going to spend on each part of the project
Research: Find out what iron is, where it comes from and why is it so important. Why is iron important to us in today's society and why did East Cleveland play such an important part in the development of Teesside's industry?	Historical evidence - Records/photos of local visits to museums
Maps and pictures of the local area - then and now.	What evidence remains from our historical heritage - photos, diagrams, maps
Examples of where iron or its derivatives are used	Information page
Ferrous - Non Ferrous metals - what's the difference?	Information page
Evaluation	Feedback from peers and adults
